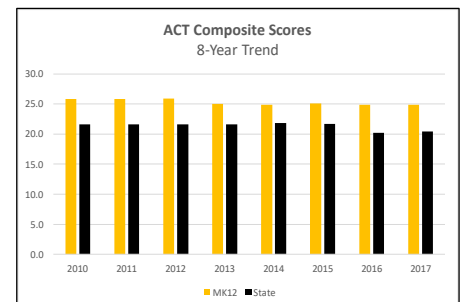

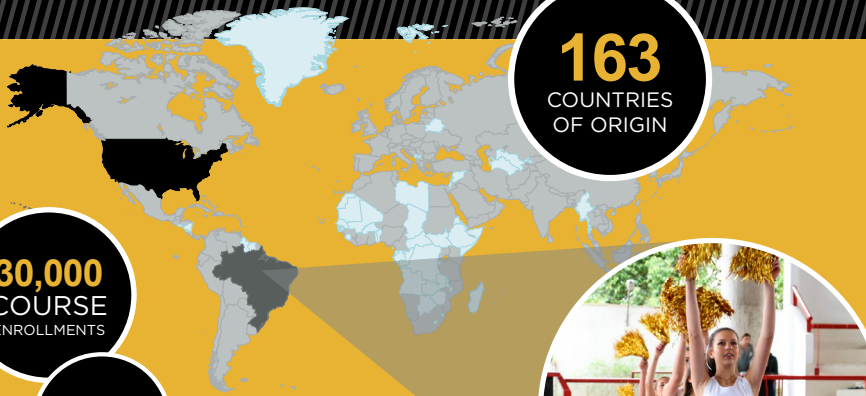
### STANDARDIZED EXAM SCORES
