PROGRAM OPTIONS

- **High School Diploma:** Fully accredited, meets Missouri state standards, custom to student post-graduation needs (i.e., U.S. college requirements)
- **MizzouDirect Diploma:** High School Diploma PLUS student's graduation plan reviewed by University of Missouri Admissions for pre-admission for undergraduate studies.
- **MizzouDirect Scholarship to College:** *MizzouDirect* graduates are eligible for an annual stackable scholarship of \$5000/year.
- **Grades 6-8 Standard Core Curriculum.** Language Arts, Math, Science, and Social Studies.
- **K-8 Mizzou Global Leaders:** Interdisciplinary experiential program using an inquiry-/project-based approach across disciplines on global issues; students will develop global awareness, critical thinking, and leadership skills.

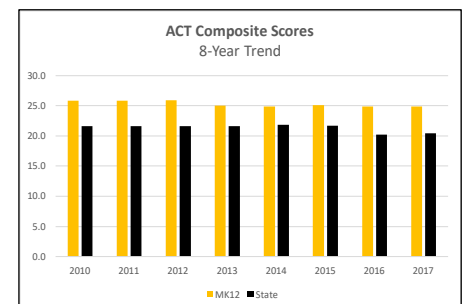
